Attendance

Attendance Counts

- School success goes hand in hand with attendance
- Chronic Absenteeism: Missing 10% or more of school in an academic year (BOTH excused & unexcused absences). For example: In a 180 day school year, missing 18 days of school.
- We are required by law to have school attendance procedures as well as consequences for school non-attendance. Every school at Beaumont Unified School District follows the same procedures for our School Attendance Review Team (SART)/Student Attendance Review Board (SARB) interventions.
- When the school has exhausted all resources and a student's attendance has not improved, then a family may be referred to a Student Attendance Review Board (SARB) hearing.


